Sunday July 26th Rivendell


Entry Fees will be \$25 for Seniors, \$15 for Juniors, and \$40 for Families (One Senior and any number of Juniors from the same address)

Social Ride Days at Fairbairn Park

The ACT Motorcycle Club has agreed to offer a "Trials" membership to Trials Club of Canberra members.

The cost will be \$50 for Adults, or \$60 for Families.

This membership will allow TCC members to ride Social Ride Days at Fairbairn Park under the ACT Motorcycle Club's Insurance agreement with Motorcycling NSW.

These fees are in addition to your TCC Membership Fees.

You can pay these memberships via Trials Club of Canberra, and I will forward the monies and your details to the ACT Motorcycle Club, who will issue you a Membership Card.

When riding at one of our Social Ride Days, you will be required to sign-on and pay the following fees to the TCC Official running the day.

MA Licenced Riders \$10

Non MA Licenced riders \$30

PLEASE NOTE: This membership is valid only for Social Riding at the trials area in Fairbairn Park. Should you wish to ride at any events organized on the Moto Cross and Dirt Track circuits, you will be required to pay full ACT Motorcycle Club membership.

Which is the right Licence for you ?

You should look at a Licence as being a licence to ride and to be covered by Insurance, not just as a competition licence.

A **National Licence** (\$290 **Senior** or \$265 **Junior**) entitles the holder to compete in all forms of Motorcycle competition.

A **Restricted National Licence** (\$200 **Senior** or \$105 **Junior**) entitles the holder to compete in all Trials competitions.

Each Licence is valid for 12 months from date of issue.

A **One Event Licence** (\$60) is only valid for Club Trial events on day of issue.

When we ride at Fairbairn Park (under the ACTMCC / MNSW Insurance agreement) you pay \$10 if you have a MA licence, or \$30 if you don't have a MA licence.

If you ride your Trials bike in three Club Trials in twelve months, you're up for \$180 for three One Event Licences.

Simple maths will tell you that a Restricted National Licence is the most cost effective, and practical, way to go.
