Keep your feet up and I'll see you soon,



Follow this in a North Easterly direction until you turn left to stay on Kybeyan Road about 4km from town. We are exactly 12km from town on the right hand side from which you will see the new majestic "Lake Christoff." Look out for the cream can with 736 and 738 written on it. You can see the trial site across the lake and up on the hill near the machinery shed.

Our first Open Trial for 2011 will be held on the 26th and 27th of March and will be Round One of the 2011 NSW Trials Championships.
