ANNOUNCEMENT: 1.

The Motorcycle Trials Club of Qld, hereafter called the PROMOTER will conduct an Invitational Club Trial on SUNDAY 26th October 2014.

JURISDICTION: 2.

- The abovementioned meeting has been authorised by Motorcycling QLD who has issued the Motorcycling Australia Permit Number 41714, and is open to holders of current Motorcycling Australia Open, Restricted, Club, One Meeting or and are full financial Members of M.C.T.Q., W.D.T.C, C.Q.T.C. or L.R.M.T.C. The Promoter reserves the right to refuse any entry, with the approval of MQ, should the circumstances warrant. (OML to Juniors if they hold a current JCP Log Book.)
- The event will be held in accordance with the 2014 Manual of Motorcycle Sport General Competition Rules (GCR's) the Australian Trials rules (23.7.3), these Supplementary Regulations, and any Final Instructions verbal or otherwise, with prior approval from Motorcycling Queensland. BY ENTERING THIS MEETING ALL PARTIES AGREE TO COMPLY WITH THESE RULES, REGULATIONS, BY-LAWS AND INSTRUCTIONS.

- 3.1. Entries open forthwith and Entries close Tuesday 21st October 2014. Entries will be accepted on the day.
- 3.2. In the case of postponement or abandonment of the meeting, all or any part of the entry fee may be retained by the Promoter, if such retention is approved by Motorcycling Queensland.
- Veterans must be over the age of 40 and will be riding C Grade line. 3.3. Juniors must be under the age of 16 as at the 1st January as per GCR 12.16.0.1.
- Only entries received on the official Entry Form that is accompanied by the correct fee will be accepted. 3.4.
- NOTE: THE RETURN OF ENTRY FEES FOR ANY RIDER WITHDRAWING FROM THE MEETING IS AT THE DISCRETION OF THE 3.5. PROMOTER.

7. CLASSES OF COMPETITION

Open Solo, B Grade, C Grade, Veteran - Aged 40 and over, Twinshock, Air Cooled Mono Shock, Clubman, Classic, Introductory, Ladies, Junior, Minibike and Intro Junior.

8. AWARDS:

Points will be awarded for each place and will be added together over the year to go towards the Club Championship trophies awarded at the end of the year Club's Presentation Event

9. ENTRIES TO CONSTITUTE A CLASS:

- 9.1. To constitute a Class, the number of contestants entered and competing in each Class shall be no less than 3.
- 9.2 Should there be insufficient entries in any Class of Competition, the decision to run or cancel the Class, or to combine classes and re-distribute any awards, will be at the discretion of the promoter, subject to Motorcycling Queensland approval.

10 RACE FORMAT:

10.1. The number of Sections and laps to be completed will be announced at rider's briefing.

11. MACHINES AND RIDERS:

- 11.1. All machines entered must comply with the current GCR's for Moto Trials Competition.
- 11.2. Multiple entry of the one Machine in the same Class of Competition is not permitted.
- 11.3. Competitors including Minders are to present themselves dressed for competition including helmet, which are to be in good condition and complies with 23.1 or 30 of the GCR's, together with bike, competition licence to Scrutineering at the time listed below.
- 11.4 Motorcycle Tyres shall be of a Universal Trials Pattern.
- 12. NAME PLATES:

Identification plates must be fitted to all machines as per GCR's 23.2.3.

13. RIDERS BRIEFING:

A Riders Briefing will be held prior to the commencement of the event and ALL Competitors / Parents / Minders MUST attend the Riders Briefing. Riders Briefing is a Non Smoking Area.

14. DRUG AND OR ALCOHOL TESTING:

- **14.1.** All competitors and officials are advised that as part of the MA drug education program, drug testing may take place at any competition in accordance with Australian Sports Commission policy as implemented by the Australian Sports Drug Agency.
- 14.2. If any doubts exist over banned substances it is recommended competitors telephone the Drugs in Sport Hotline 1800 020506. When drug testing takes place, the presentation of awards may be delayed at the Motorcycling Queensland discretion until the results of the tests are known.

15. CODE OF CONDUCT:

All Competitors, Officials and Parents are reminded of the Motorcycling Australia By-Law - CODE OF CONDUCT (as stipulated in the GCR's) which is a guide to appropriate behaviour at all Motorcycle Race Meetings. This CODE OF CONDUCT applies to this Meeting and will be enforced.

Competitors handing in a scorecard more than 30 minutes after sections closed will be excluded from results (DNF).

2. DEFINITIONS In this declaration:

- "Claim" means and includes any action, suit, proceeding, claim, demand, damage, cost or expense however arising including but not limited to negligence but does not include a claim against a Motorcycling Organisation under any right expressly conferred by its constitution or regulation:
- "Indemnitees" means and includes the persons, organisations and bodies corporate whose names appear in Schedule 1.
- "MA" means Motorcycling Australia Limited;
- "State Controlling Body" (SCB) means a state or territory motorcycling association affiliated as a member of MA:
- "Motorcycling Activities" means performing or participating in any capacity in any authorised or recognised Motorcycling Organisation event, neeting or activity;
- "Motorcycling Organisation" means and includes MA, and the MA members (including the SCBs and affiliated clubs) and where the context so permits, their respective directors, officers, members, servants or agents.

3. ACKNOWLEDGMENT OF RISKS, DANGERS & OBLIGATIONS

I ACKNOWI FDGF that:

- motorcycle sport is dangerous and that by engaging in the sport (whether as a competitor, recreational rider, coach, official or media) at the Meeting I take and am exposed to certain risks and dangers and am under certain obligations as follows:
- that I may be injured, physically or mentally, and may be killed;
- that my machinery or equipment may be damaged, lost or destroyed; that competitors may ride dangerously or with a lack of skill;
- that track or event conditions may be hazardous and may vary without warning or predictability;
- that organisers, officials, landowners/track operators and any agents or representatives of those in charge of meetings are frequently obliged to make decisions under pressure of time/or events;
- that any policy of insurance of or in respect of my life or physical or mental health may be voided;
- that there may be no or inadequate facilities for treatment or transport of me if I am injured;
- that I have an obligation to myself and to others to act safely and within the rules and regulations of MA; the Indemnitees do not make any warranty that the services at the
- Meeting will be provided with due care and skill or that any materials provided in connection with the services will be fit for the purpose for which they are supplied; to the extent that any warranty is implied it is excluded to the full extent
- permitted by law:
- have voluntarily read and understood this warning and accept and assume the inherent risks in participating in the Event.

4. WARNING UNDER THE FAIR TRADING ACT 1999 (VIC)

Under the provisions of the Fair Trading Act 1999 (Vic) several conditions are implied into contracts for the supply of certain goods and services. These conditions mean that the supplier named on this form is required to ensure that the recreational services it supplies to you are:

- as fit for the purpose for which they are commonly bought as it is reasonable to expect in the circumstances; and
- reasonably fit for any particular purpose or might reasonably be

expected to achieve any result you have made known to the supplier. Under section 32N of the Fair Trading Act 1999, the supplier is entitled to ask you to agree that these conditions do not apply to you.
