1 ANNOUNCEMENT:

The Western Districts Trials Club and Sunshine Coast Motorcycle Club, hereafter called the PROMOTING CLUBS will conduct the Twin Shock Masters Interclub Observed Moto Trial at Green Park, Conondale on Saturday 1st and Sunday 2nd November, 2014, as per Permit Applications applied for.

2 JURISDICTION:

2.1 The abovementioned meeting has been authorised by MQ who has issued the Motorcycling Australia 41724 and is open to holders of current Motorcycling Australia National, Club, Mini and One Meeting Licences, who are full financial members of one of the Participating Clubs **WDTC-SCMC**, **LRMTC**, **MTCQ** and **CQTC** (no discount or one day memberships are allowed). (OML to junior riders only if they hold a current JCP Log Book).

2.2 The event will be held in accordance with the current General Competition Rules (GCR's) contained in the Manual of Motorcycle Sport, the Australian Trials rules (23.7.3), these Supplementary Regulations, and any Final Instructions verbal or otherwise, with prior approval from Motorcycling Queensland

By entering this meeting all parties agree to comply with these rules, regulations, by-laws and instructions All bikes entered must comply with Section 23 of the GCR including the use of Lanyard Kill Switch and Shark Fin type sprocket guard.

3 ENTRIES:

- 3.1 Entries open forthwith and **close last mail Friday 24th October 2014**. Entries received after this date will not qualify for meals for the WDTC Christmas Party or One-Meeting Licences. **Entries are capped at 150** and any entries over this number will not be accepted even if they are received before the close of entries.
- 3.2 In the case of postponement or abandonment of the meeting, all or any part of the entry fee may be retained by the Club, if such retention is approved by MQ.
- 3.3 Only entries received on the official Entry Form that are accompanied by the correct fee will be accepted up to 150 entries. If payment made by EFT, confirmation of EFT payment must be sent with entries.

4 INSURANCE:

- 4.1 National Personal Accident Scheme provides basic cover for death and permanent disability.
- 4.2 Ambulance Insurance is compulsory for licensees.
- 4.3 It is strongly recommended that competitors give consideration to taking out weekly benefits insurance.

8 CLASSES OF COMPETITION:

Competitive Twin Shock Classes:

Open Twin Shock (post classic competing on blue line) - open to all riders; Clubperson Twin Shock (post classic competing on white lines) - only open to clubman riders; Introductory Twin Shock (post classic competing on Introductory lines) – only open to introductory riders;

Twinshock Junior – Junior riders on a twinshock bike are to enter classes as per conditions above. First place will be awarded for the highest placed junior in each of the twinshock classes;

Ladies Twin Shock – Lady riders on a twinshock bike are to enter the classes as per conditions above. First place will be awarded for the highest placed lady rider in each of the twinshock classes;

Classic A (pre-65 competing on white line);

Classic B (pre-65 competing on introductory lines) - Note classic classes may be combined depending on numbers- if classes are combined, award goes to best placed classic in the highest grade;

Twinshock Sidecar;

Moving Display Class (heavy bikes riding separate sections incorporating turns and small obstacles).

Note: All other entries into these classes must be non-competitive ie if a B grade rider chooses to enter Clubperson Twin Shock it must be non-competitive.

Support Classes:

A & B combined; C Grade; Clubperson & Junior combined; Introductory

Air Cooled Monoshock – All riders on ACM to enter the appropriate Support Class. An award will be given for the highest placed ACM.

PLEASE NOTE: All competitors may enter one class only.

NOTE to INTERSTATE Riders: QLD grading of lines tends to be harder than other states ie QLD C Grade (blue line) equivalent to NSW C+ or easy B grade, QLD Clubman (white line) equivalent to NSW C grade

9 AWARDS AND PRIZEMONEY:

Competitive Twin Shock and Classic Classes: Trophies will be presented to first 5 places. Junior and Ladies Twinshock: First place trophy for best Lady and Junior in each of the Twinshock Classes Support Classes: Medallions to be presented to 1st, 2nd & 3rd. Air Cooled Monoshock presented with a 1st place medallion.

10 ENTRIES TO CONSTITUTE A CLASS:

- 10.1 To constitute a Class, the number of contestants entered and competing in each Class shall be 3.
- 10.2 Should there be insufficient entries in any Class of Competition, the decision to run or cancel the Class, or to combine events, will be at the discretion of the Western Districts Trials Club, subject to Motorcycling Queensland approval.

11 RACE FORMAT:

Details will be provided at briefing. All riders must attend riders briefing

12 MACHINES AND RIDERS:

- 12.1 All machines entered must comply with the current GCR's for Moto Trials Competition including lanyard kill switch and shark fin style sprocket guard.
- 12.2 Multiple entry of the one Machine in the same Class of Competition is not permitted with the exception of Twin Shock Sidecar and Moving Display class.
- 12.3 Change of machine may be allowed at discretion of the Steward.
- 12.4 Helmets are mandatory. All persons including officials using any bike (including pushbikes), trike or quad at an event must be wearing a properly secured helmet.

13 RIDING NUMBERS:

All Number Plates on all Machines MUST comply with the GCR's.

14 GRID POSITIONS:

A Riders Briefing will be held prior to the commencement of racing and ALL Competitors MUST attend the Riders Briefing. Riders Briefing is a Non Smoking Area.

- 16.1 All competitors and officials are advised that as part of the MA drug education program, drug testing may take place at any competition in accordance with Australian Sports Commission policy as implemented by the Australian Sports Drug Agency.
- 16.2 If any doubts exist over banned substances it is recommended competitors telephone the Drugs in Sport Hotline 1800 020506. When drug testing takes place, the payment of prize money may be delayed at MQ discretion until the results of the tests are known.

HEREBY AGREE with Motorcycling Australia Limited ("MA") that I am by this agreement entitled to participate in the motorcycle activity/meeting listed in Schedule 2 (hereinafter called "the Meeting" or the "Event") at the venue listed at Schedule 3 (hereinafter called "the Venue") on the terms and conditions set out in this document.

2. DEFINITIONS In this declaration:

- means and includes any action, suit, proceeding, claim, "Claim a) a) demand, damage, cost or expense however arising including but not limited to negligence but does not include a claim against a Motorcycling Organisation under any right expressly conferred by its constitution or regulation;
- "Indemnitees" means and includes the persons, organisations and h) bodies corporate whose names appear in Schedule 1.
- "MA" means Motorcycling Australia Limited; "State Controlling Body" (SCB) means a state or territory motorcycling d) association affiliated as a member of MA;
- e) "Motorcycling Activities" means performing or participating in any capacity in any authorised or recognised Motorcycling Organisation event, meeting or activity;
- f) "Motorcycling Organisation" means and includes MA, and the MA members (including the SCBs and affiliated clubs) and where the context so permits, their respective directors, officers, members, servants or agents.

ACKNOWLEDGMENT OF RISKS, DANGERS & OBLIGATIONS

I ACKNOWLEDGE that:

- motorcycle sport is dangerous and that by engaging in the sport a) (whether as a competitor, recreational rider, coach, official or media) at the Meeting I take and am exposed to certain risks and dangers and am under certain obligations as follows:
- that I may be injured, physically or mentally, and may be killed; that my machinery or equipment may be damaged, lost or destroyed;

- that track or event conditions may be hazardous and may vary without warning or predictability; v) that organisers, officials, landowners/track operators and any agents or
- representatives of those in charge of meetings are frequently obliged to make decisions under pressure of time/or events; vi) that any policy of insurance of or in respect of my life or physical or
- mental health may be voided; that there may be no or inadequate facilities for treatment or transport of vii)
- me if I am injured; that I have an obligation to myself and to others to act safely and within vii) the rules and regulations of MA;
- b) the Indemnitees do not make any warranty that the services at the Meeting will be provided with due care and skill or that any materials provided in connection with the services will be fit for the purpose for which they are supplied;
- to the extent that any warranty is implied it is excluded to the full extent c) permitted by law;
- d) have voluntarily read and understood this warning and accept and assume the inherent risks in participating in the Event.

4. WARNING UNDER THE FAIR TRADING ACT 1999 (VIC)

I understand it is compulsory for me to have ambulance insurance in some form and I accept responsibility for the cost of ambulance transportation, ambulance cover and further agree to maintain ambulance cover during the term of my license / membership.
