1. ANNOUNCEMENT:

The Motorcycle Trials Club Of Queensland, hereafter called the PROMOTING CLUB, will conduct a Two Day Interclub incorporating Rounds 2 & 3 of QMTS at 2621 Beaudesert Nerang Rd Benobble Near Canungra as per Permit Applications applied for.

2. JURISDICTION:

- 2.1. The abovementioned meeting has been authorised by MQ who has issued the Motorcycling Australia Permit Number 42323 and is open to holders of current Motorcycling Australia National, National Restricted, One Meeting, and Recreational non-competitive Licences who are full financial members of the participating clubs MTCQ, WDTC, LRMTC or CQTC. (OML to junior riders if they hold a current JCP Log Book)
- 2.2. The meeting will be held in accordance with the current Manual of Motorcycle Sport General Competition Rules (GCR's), these Supplementary Regulations, and any Final Instructions approved by MQ.

BY ENTERING THIS MEETING ALL PARTIES AGREE TO COMPLY WITH THESE RULES, REGULATIONS, BY-LAWS AND INSTRUCTIONS.

3. ENTRIES:

- 3.1. Entries open forthwith, and close last mail Fri 18th March or via www.nominate.com.au at midnight Wed 23rd March 2016
- 3.2. In the case of postponement or abandonment of the meeting, all or any part of the entry fee may be retained by the Promoting Club, if such retention is approved by MQ.

9 AWARDS AND PRIZEMONEY:

Trophies or awards will be presented to 1st,2nd,&3rd to all grades excluding Veterans. Veterans will be presented trophies or awards for 1st place in each grade only. In the event of only three (3) entries in one class trophies or awards will be presented for 1st place only.

10 ENTRIES TO CONSTITUTE A CLASS:

- 10.1. To constitute a Class, the number of contestants entered and competing in each Class shall be 2
- 10.2 Should there be insufficient entries in any Class of Competition, the decision to run or cancel the Class, or to combine events and re-distribute any awards, will be at the discretion of the club, subject to MQ approval.

11 RACE FORMAT:

The number of sections and laps to be completed will be announced at rider's briefing.

12 MACHINES AND RIDERS:

- 12.1. All machines entered must comply with the current GCR's for Moto Trials Competition.
- 12.2. Multiple entry of the one Machine in the same Class of Competition is not permitted.
- 12.3. Competitors including Minders are to present themselves dressed for competition including helmet, which are in good condition and complies with 23.1 or 30 of the GCR's, together with bike, competition licence to Scrutineering at the time listed below.
- 12.4 Change of machinery may be allowed subject to discretion of the Steward.
- 12.5 Motorcycle tyres shall be of a Trials Universal Pattern.
- 12.6 Helmets are mandatory. All persons including officials using any bike, trike, or quad at an event must be wearing a properly secured helmet.

- 15 NAME PLATES: Identification Plates must be fitted to all machines as per GCR's 23.2.3.

16 DRUG AND OR ALCOHOL TESTING:

- 16.1 All competitors and officials are advised that as part of the MA drug education program, drug testing may take place at any competition in accordance with Australian Sports Commission policy as implemented by the Australian Sports Drug Agency.
- 16.2 If any doubts exist over banned substances it is recommended competitors telephone the Drugs in Sport Hotline 1800 020506. When drug testing takes place, the payment of prizemoney may be delayed at MQ discretion until the results of the tests are known.

1. I THE UNDERSIGNED (see below):

HEREBY AGREE with Motorcycling Australia Limited ("MA") that I am by this agreement entitled to participate in the motorcycle activity/meeting listed in Schedule 2 (hereinafter called "the Meeting" or the "Event") at the venue listed at Schedule 3 (hereinafter called "the Venue") on the terms and conditions set out in this document.

2. DEFINITIONS In this declaration:

- "Claim" means and includes any action, suit, proceeding, claim, demand, damage, cost or expense however arising including but not limited to negligence but does not include a claim against a Motorcycling Organisation under any right expressly conferred by its constitution or regulation;
- "Indemnitees" means and includes the persons, organisations and bodies corporate whose names appear in Schedule 1.
- "MA" means Motorcycling Australia Limited;
 "State Controlling Body" (SCB) means a state or territory motorcycling association affiliated as a member of MA; d)
- "Motorcycling Activities" means performing or participating in any capacity in any authorised or recognised Motorcycling Organisation event, meeting or activity;
- "Motorcycling Organisation" means and includes MA, and the MA members (including the SCBs and affiliated clubs) and where the context so permits, their respective directors, officers, members, servants or agents.

3. ACKNOWLEDGMENT OF RISKS, DANGERS & OBLIGATIONS

I ACKNOWLEDGE that:

- motorcycle sport is dangerous and that by engaging in the sport (whether as a competitor, recreational rider, coach, official or media) at the Meeting I take and am exposed to certain risks and dangers and am under certain obligations as follows:
- that I may be injured, physically or mentally, and may be killed; that my machinery or equipment may be damaged, lost or destroyed;
- that competitors may ride dangerously or with a lack of skill;
- that track or event conditions may be hazardous and may vary without warning or predictability;
- that organisers, officials, landowners/track operators and any agents or representatives of those in charge of meetings are frequently obliqed to make decisions under pressure of time/or events;
- that any policy of insurance of or in respect of my life or physical or
- mental health may be voided; that there may be no or inadequate facilities for treatment or transport of me if I am injured;
- that I have an obligation to myself and to others to act safely and within the rules and regulations of MA; vii)
- the Indemnitees do not make any warranty that the services at the Meeting will be provided with due care and skill or that any materials provided in connection with the services will be fit for the purpose for which they are supplied;
- to the extent that any warranty is implied it is excluded to the full extent permitted by law;
- have voluntarily read and understood this warning and accept and assume the inherent risks in participating in the Event.

4. WARNING UNDER THE FAIR TRADING ACT 1999 (VIC)
