1. ANNOUNCEMENT

The Trials Club of Victoria hereinafter called the PROMOTER, will conduct the first round of the Victorian Interclub Trial Series at Sedgwick on Sunday 26th April 2015.

JURISDICTION

The abovementioned meeting has been authorised by Motorcycling Victoria (MV) and will be held in accordance with the General Competition Rules (GCR's) of Motorcycling Australia (MA), the by-laws of MV, these Supplementary Regulations and any final instructions issued by the stewards of the meeting.

BY ENTERING THIS MEETING ALL PARTIES AGREE TO COMPLY WITH THESE RULES, REGULATIONS, BY-LAWS AND INSTRUCTIONS.

3. ENTRIES

Entries will be accepted forthwith from current MA Senior National (SNA) and MA Junior National (JNA) competition licence holders. Current competition licence and current club membership card must be produced at sign in. Juniors must produce log books. NO EXCEPTIONS.

Only entries received on the official Entry Form will be accepted. Entries must be accompanied by a cheque or money order made payable to the Trials Club of Victoria. No cash by post. Incorrectly filled out Entry Form may result in entry not being accepted.

4. MEDICAL SERVICES

Level 2 First Aid or higher will be in attendance from the entirety of the event.

Sign in for the abovementioned event will take place from 9:30am.

6. RIDERS BRIEFING

Attendance at the Riders Briefing is compulsory. The Riders Briefing will take place at 10:15am. NO RIDING BEFORE BRIEFING.

7. TEMPORARY GUARDIAN

Riders under the age of 18, if not accompanied by parents, must have a guardianship form filled out prior to the event and presented at sign in. The guardian must be over 18 years and have ID.

8. MINIMUM ENTRIES

Three (3) entries to constitute a class. Grades may be combined with higher or lower grade if insufficient entries are received to constitute a class. The club reserves the right to cancel / combine classes at its discretion.

A Class must be constituted at two rounds to be considered for Series Awards

A Class (except Sidecar) with less than three entries at a round may be combined with another class

Class riders must hold "full" licences to be eligible for awards, i.e. a licence other than REC. Note that trophies may not be prepared for grades having fewer than three pre-entries.

10. WORK A ROUND FOR SERIES POINTS

If your club required extra help on the day (Observer, Scorekeeper etc.) you can elect to work one of the rounds of the Victorian Interclub Trial Series that your club hosts (rather than ride) and you will be credited with series points equal to the highest point score you achieved throughout the Series.

This initiative is intended to spread the event administration load further across the Trial's community and minimize competition penalties on event administrators.

Juniors will not be allocated worker points (we want them riding!)

11. MACHINE EXAMINATION

All machines must comply with the 2015 GCR's and these Supplementary Regulations, including correct colour nameplates.

Scrutineering takes place from 9:30am - 10:10am.

12. LANYARDS

All machines (competitors and Officials) must be fitted with an effective ignition cut-out switch operating on the primary circuit secured to the handlebars and attached by a lanyard to the rider while the machine is in operation at all times, such that a separation of the machine and rider will activate the ignition cut-out circuit.

Failure to comply will attract an additional five point penalty which can be applied by either the Observer, Clerk of Course or Steward.

13. REFUELING

Fuel Containers must comply with the 2015 GCRs.

14. AWARDS

As per subcommittee ruling. Championship as per the GCRs. Maximum of four rounds out of five will count towards series awards. No minimum rounds.

15. CAMPING

Free camping on site at all rounds.

16. CODE OF CONDUCT

All competitors, officials and parents are reminded of the Motorcycling Australia By-Law – CODE OF CONDUCT (as stipulated in the GCR's) which is a guide to appropriate behaviour at all motorcycle race meetings. This CODE OF CONDUCT applies to this meeting and will be enforced.

17. TIMETABLE FOR EVENT

Riders Briefing 10:15am

Racing Starts 10:30am (1 point penalty per minute late for book-in after start of event)

Racing Concludes 3:30pm (Last lap cards to be handed in within 15 minutes of finish time. 1 point penalty per minute late).

18. KEY POINTS

Highest series points over four rounds are eligible for the Series awards.

No minimum rounds.

Both the Entry and Indemnity Forms are required for each event.

Expert and A-Grade riders timed to 90 second rule.

In the event of a series tie of any place getter, their highest place at the final round (five) will be awarded the higher place. Any individual round tie is as per GCRs.

Some clubs will accept Direct Money Transfer for Pre-Entries.

19. DIRECTIONS

From Sedgwick, travel west on Springs Rd. After 3.6km you will meet Mandurang South Rd intersection. Continue straight ahead on Bryden Rd for 1.3km. Site is on the right, signs erected on the day.

GENERAL

- 1. **Noise:** Noise emissions must comply with rules 23.13.1.1. and 23.13.1.2. in the *2015 Manual of Motorcycle Sport* and not exceed 112dB(A) with a 4dB(A) allowance.
- 2. **Points Score**: As per 2015 Manual of Motorcycle Sport.
- 3. **Riding of Motorcycles:** The riding of any competing motorcycles in the pits or car park or camping area is not permitted. No pit bikes or non-competing motorcycles are permitted to be ridden at any time at the venue.
- 4. **Abandonment:** In the event of the meeting being abandoned due to circumstances beyond the control of the promoters before racing commences, entry fees will be returned, less a fee per entry to cover administration costs. Once the competition has commenced only the stewards of the meeting have the authority to abandon the meeting and their decision shall be final. In such cases the stewards will rule on the results according to the circumstances.
- 5. Reservations: The Stewards of the meeting reserve the right to alter, postpone or cancel all or part of the events program.
- IMPORTANT NOTICE TO ALL RIDERS/ENTRANTS/PARENTS/GUARDIANS: CAPITAL BENEFITS INSURANCE IS APPLICABLE TO ALL RIDERS WITH A CURRENT LICENCE.
